When you submit your CE evaluations online, you will receive your official CE Statement of Credit to print for your records **INSTANTLY!** **You will only have 6 weeks to submit your online evaluation for the program - the deadline is July 28, 2016.**

Step 1 (Logging In)

Visit www.ncpalearn.org. Please use Google Chrome for this site instead of Internet Explorer.

Step 2 (Creating a Username/Password)

If you were a registered Pharmacist e-Link™ user, log in using your username. **Use the temporary password of ncpa2016.** Once you are logged in you will have the option to change your password. If you are a NEW user, click "Register" to create a FREE account.

Step 3 (Selecting a Course/Meeting)

After logging into www.ncpalearn.org, choose **ASAP 2016 Midyear Conference** from the list of LIVE Meetings.

Step 4 (Verifying Your Profession)

Once you are on the ASAP 2016 Midyear Conference course overview, select **Click for More Information**. Then select your **Profession** from the list provided. **You will need to enter the access code: asap62016.**

Step 5 (e-Profile ID)

Please provide your e-Profile ID you obtained from CPE Monitor as well as your date of birth (MMDD). This information is required in order to receive the CPE credit for this program. If you do not have an e-Profile ID, please go to www.cpemonitor.com and register to receive your ID.

Step 6 (Completing the Course Evaluation)

Check the box next to the program(s) attended. You will then be required to complete a brief online evaluation before clicking on the **Submit** button.

Step 7 (CE Activity Submission)

Your CE activity will be submitted to NABP for the CPE Monitor System immediately after the **July 28** deadline for the online evaluation submission of the program.
